High-quality care is important for the growth, development and the health of a child. Access to early childhood education and care is an important social determinant of health. Because the first six years of life are a critical time for cognitive development, early childhood learning and care has a large impact on children's health and well-being, as well as their later development. High quality early childhood education and care programs are well-documented to have positive impacts which last throughout the life course. (Wellesley 2015)

Child development is cumulative in nature. A nurturing and stimulating environment will promote learning skills that in turn allow the child's curiosity and creativity to blossom and may even "open future possibilities in spite of biological interventions" (Shanker 2008)
